

Lake Nakuru National Park - a two-day safari -



Lake Nakuru is a big national park, which has lots of animals such as: lions, hyenas, giraffes, rhinos (the famous white rhino), warthogs, wildebeest, gazelles, monkeys, flamingos and so many other animals. Seeing lots of wildlife is a guarantee. The best option for visiting is to make it a two-day trip.

This way you can make a game drive (a drive through the park to see the wildlife) during sunset and again the next morning.

The trip: You will depart at 10 or 11 am, using a special safari van – it has a roof that can be opened for better viewing. You will have a professional safari driver, to give you the best experience and highest chance to see lots of animals. It's a 4-hour drive from Eldoret to Nakuru park – but a very beautiful drive. You will be given take away lunch (sandwiches, eggs and fruits) by our chef.



You enter the national park in the afternoon and make a game drive to see the wild life, before going to your guesthouse. You will spend the night at a guesthouse from the Wildlife club of Kenya, where you get a comfortable bed, with bathroom (hot shower). You will be served dinner by our chef (generally soup as a starter, main dish with chicken, rice and vegetables, fruits and tea/coffee, vegetarian option available).

The next morning you will have breakfast at 6 am and then leave at 6.30 to make a long game drive to see the wild, from 6.30 am until around 11 am. Once you are done with the game drive, you will pick up your luggage and leave the park.

After this, you will drive to Nairobi, where you will be dropped off at JKIA international airport. The driver will stop for lunch in a restaurant on the way. This lunch is self-paid – the other meals are all included in the price. Also included is all transport, the park fee, the game drives and the guesthouse.
